6 December 2016

Northerams Wood

We started off coppicing hazel in the woodland near the pond and burning the cleared material on a bonfire. Some of us then moved on to digging out yellow flag iris from the bed of the pond with forks. This was a very difficult job. Further work with a larger number of people would be needed to make significant impact on the flag iris.

10 volunteers were present.

Previous visits

BCV last visited Northerams Wood on 1 March 2016. We cleared a ditch, cleared an overgrown path and cut down laurel. We also made safe some trees overhanging paths. BFC Ranger was Alison.

Northerams Wood

A 400-year old woodland, which was originally run as a Nature Reserve by BBOWT but has now been taken over by Bracknell Town Council. Recent work has included hazel coppicing and building all-weather paths. There is a pond and wild flower meadow. Bluebells flower in season. Other wild flowers include grass vetchling, early purple orchid, common spotted orchid, wood anemones, cowslips and betony. The park has been designated a Local Wildlife Site because of its important wildlife.

The remains of a railway track can still be seen in part of the wood. This may have been built to transport ammunition during the last war.

From the archives - A day to remember

Toads in trouble

The common toad (*Bufo bufo*) is a creature of habit. When they are ready to breed, toads often return to the pond in which they grew up. Unfortunately, this can include crossing roads. Volunteers who run toad patrols to help the toads reach their breeding grounds safely have reported an average 68% decline in toad numbers in the UK. A similar pattern has been seen in Switzerland.
