Mill Lane / Babbage Way

The first job was to clear vegetation at the back of houses. Some substantial tipping of rubbish had taken place here, making access very difficult.

Another group started on the task of clearing about 2m of vegetation at the edge of the roundabout in Babbage Way.. This was a large job; the volunteers who had worked elsewhere moved here after lunch, and the task was eventually completed.

The third group replaced some sections of chestnut post-and-rail fencing.
