## **Nightingale Triangle**

We cleared scrub from areas on the bank bordering the footpath/cycleway which are destined for future bulb planting. Some volunteers used a winch to pull up rhododendron stumps. Other volunteers cleared brambles and invasive tree seedlings from an area where we plan to plant bluebell bulbs in November. Cleared material was burnt on a bonfire.

Weather was overcast, but we had no more than a few spots of rain.
