5 April 2022

Lily Hill Park

We added 3 posts to the lych gate uprights. One post had already been done. We removed a picket fence from the pub cellar entrance and made a new fence to protect it. We cleared scrub around the area and burned on a bonfire.

15 volunteers attended. Weather was warm and overcast and dry. Smoke from the bonfire drifted in an easterly direction, towards Ascot.

The main task was digging a pond at a damp patch in the meadow. The pond was dug to be deep in the middle with terraced sides. We also cut back blackthorn overgrowing the gate and path at the top of the meadow, and cleared some patches of blackthorn in the field.

18 volunteers attended. The weather was surprisingly warm for the time of year. Some rain was forecast, but did not appear. Sunny with some light cloud and a gentle breeze.
