19 April 2022

Frost Folly

- 1) Our first task was to fix the fence protecting the wildlife pond from the path.
- 2) We removed baler twine from a number of old hay bales and spread the material out to form a mulch.
- 3) We removed tree guards which were broken or where the trees had died.

17 volunteers attended. The weather was cloudy; some rain had been forecast for the afternoon but fortunately there were only a few drops.

Other volunteers pulled pine, bramble and birch from an area covered with heather just beyond the noticeboard on the path to the lake. The cleared material was transported by hand in big bags to areas among the pine trees nearby.
