12 July 2022

Savernake Park

We cleared vegetation to expose a metal safety fence, which we then rubbed down and painted. Unfortunately the dark green paint transferred itself to skin and clothing. Other volunteers cleared vegetation from around some young trees.

14 volunteers attended, The weather was hot and overcast with some sunny intervals.

26 July 2022

The Parks

We cleared holly to widen a path in the woodland near Hurricane Gate and allow more light in to help other broadleaved species to establish. In the morning, subgroups of volunteers cleared an area of ragwort and helped the BFC ranger tidy up the fence line alongside the road. A ragwort plant which had cinnabar moth caterpillars in residence was left in place.

The weather was overcast but warm. We had a very good turnout of 23 volunteers. A local resident praised the work we were doing, and two other residents offered tea and coffee.
