

6 September 2022

South Hill Park

We cleared brambles at South wood, on the right hand side of the path going up the hill, fairly close to the amphitheatre where we have worked previously. Cleared material was collected and piled at the edge of the lawn for later collection by the rangers. Rangers thanked us for the work we had done.

The weather was muggy and mostly dry up to 11:00, with some rain thereafter. We missed the heavy rain which came on later in the afternoon,
