13 December 2022

Tarmans Copse

A smallish group of 13 volunteers gathered on a cold, frosty morning. We planted tree whips (oak, hawthorn, hornbeam, hazel) in an area of cleared woodland. Some areas were too hard frozen to be feasible for tree planting, in other areas it was quite easy to get a spade in. We had a small bonfire for warming purposes.

The weather was cold, with a watery sun trying to shine through.

The task was to construct more secure dams for the 2 main ponds. Over the course of the day the group made five new dams, dug one new pond and started enhancing a bog area.

Other volunteers coppiced hazel in a separate compartment and cleared holly and bramble. Cleared material was piled into habitat piles or stacked in a pen made from hazel offcuts. Some coppiced stools were protected with deer cages made from these offcuts.

We had a very good turnout of 22 volunteers. The weather was pleasantly warm, a contrast to last week's snow. It got quite warm in the sun at times.

Long-standing volunteer Michael J Norton remembered that he attended his first ever BCV task at Farley Copse, 25 years ago.
