3 January 2023

Farley Copse

We cleared bramble, holly and laurel from an area close to the line of Leylandii trees. Some of the cleared material was burnt on a fire the other side of the path. A habitat pile was created further into the area cleared.

11 volunteers attended. The weather was drizzly until about 11:00.

10 January 2023

Nightingale Triangle

Tasks were as follows:

1. Burn previously cut brash on bonfire
2. Clean bird nesting boxes: a volunteer used a ladder for this task
3. Cut down rhododendron and burn on bonfire
4. Remove gorse, rhododendron regrowth and small trees from the bank near the footpath from the underpass.

14 volunteers attended. The weather was rainy.
