17 January 2023

Lark's Hill

On a bitterly cold morning we pruned the orchard trees, removing diseased, damaged or crossing branches and trying to produce a "goblet" shape, and creating space between neighbouring trees.

Prunings were piled in suitable places to be picked up later for shredding.

11 volunteers attended. The weather was very cold; the ground was frozen, but luckily there was not much wind.

24 January 2023

Edmunds Green

We coppiced an area south of the hedge between the orchard and the road, and cleared some holly. Stakes and binders were produced and piled to be used to create a dead hedge around the orchard later in the year.

24 volunteers attended. The weather was cold (about freezing) and dry.
