We cleared holly, rhododendron and laurel in a corner of the wood. We successfully cleared a large area allowing light through and encouraging understory growth. Cleared material was burnt on a bonfire.

What appeared to be a badger sett with several entrances was found on part of the site, this was reported to BFC rangers, who were not aware of it before.

We had a foggy start, but it gradually cleared. 19 volunteers attended.

22 volunteers attended. The weather was overcast but dry, although there was some light drizzle when we met in the car park.
