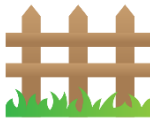
What we've been doing

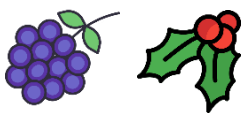


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9 September 2025

South Hill Park



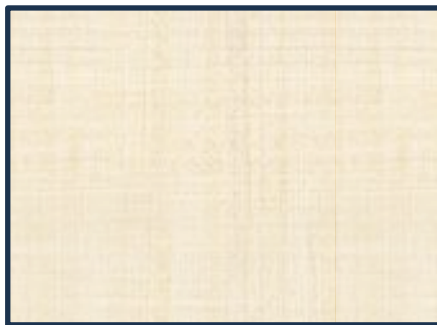
Task: Dig out one of the terrace beds at the rear of the arts centre ready for grass planting and remove weeds from the other one

Englemere Pond



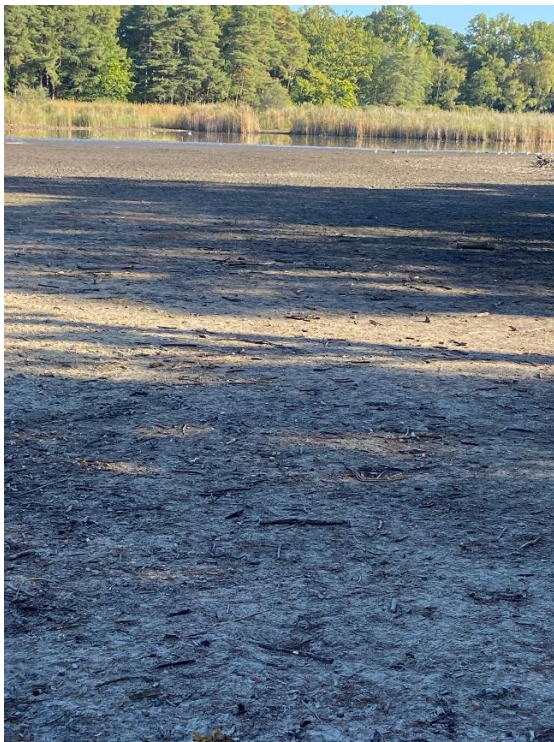
Task: Cutting shrubs and making a dead hedge alongside pond
