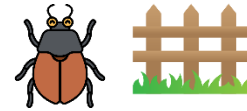

Weather: Mainly sunny with a few clouds

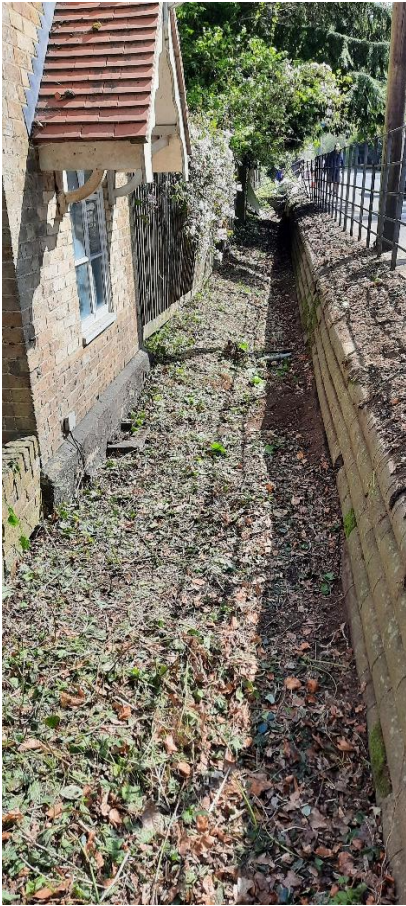
