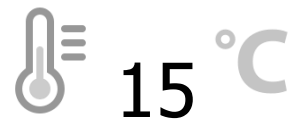
Buckler's Park

12 May 2026

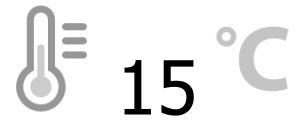
Buckler's Park & Lily Hill Park
